Student transfers:

Outgoing Transfers

Walsall College has no formal method of transfer for students wishing to study elsewhere. The College does however formally record unitised attainment as and when this occurs which can support Students when wishing to apply elsewhere. In the unlikely event of a student wanting to cease their study with us and migrate to study elsewhere (perhaps when relocating home for example), it falls within the remit of the new institutions practice when considering the request to transfer across to them and their own admissions policy.

Where Walsall College students have completed Pearson BTEC units, any unit/module attainment will be recorded and certificates will be claimed. Institutions will want to ensure that the applicant is in a position where the appropriate level and stage of study can be agreed. It is entirely at their discretion whether they accept applicants' mid-way through qualifications or not. Walsall College staff will endeavour to support each student on a case by case basis through impartial advice and guidance as well as through direct contact to other institutions where appropriate.

Incoming Transfers

In the case of students wishing to move from another institution and join a Walsall College programme of study at any point beyond its natural start date, the College will deploy the appropriate consideration of their prior achievement and or experience via our Recognition of Prior Learning policy. In this case it is within our discretion when considering a student's readiness to join a programme where they have missed significant tuition and guided learning and or where there may be attainment gaps.
