



ALLERGIES AND ALLERGIC REACTIONS

All staff are required to be Paediatric first aid trained and aware of all children with known allergies within the nursery.

Staff should be familiar with common Signs and Symptoms of Allergies and Allergic reactions, if you are not sure of this please seek advice from Nursery Management team

Parents/carers must complete the relevant section on their child's registration form if their child has any known allergies.

Children who need medication of any kind are administered; the correct dosage from the medicine form signed by the parent, and the medicine bottle is checked against this to make sure the amounts are correct, and the medicine is in date and for the correct child.

First Aider is present at all times, including on outings and any relevant medication is taken, along with medication form.

Kitchen staff are made aware of all dietary requirements using the correct Dietary requirement form. Parents/carers to inform staff of any changes to their child/rens health and dietary needs.

Parents are asked to bring all medication required to the nursery at all times. The nursery has a lockable medicine cabinet where medication can be stored safely.
