

ALL THINGS RESIDENCY

To enable us to enrol you onto a funded course, we must ensure that you are eligible for funding.

As part of these eligibility checks, we have to determine whether we can treat you as a home student by checking your immigration permissions.

The initial checks are to determine whether you are a UK/Irish Citizen and have been ordinarily resident in the UK for the past 3 years.

If you don't meet this residency criteria, then we will need to see your residency documentation. This documentation could be in the form of one or more of the following;

- Passport and/or Visa
- Biometric Residence Permit
- Home Office letter to confirm receipt of application for leave
- Asylum – Applications Registration Card (ARC)
- Asylum application Home Office Standard Acknowledgement Letter (SAL)
- If you have leave to join a family member we will also need to see the family member's passport or visa.
- Solicitor's letter to confirm application for leave has been sent before the current leave status expires.
- EU Settlement Scheme Share Code

The expiry date of your leave status will also need to be after the planned end date of the course that you wish to enrol onto. We will identify the planned end date when enrolling.

Some of our courses can become over-subscribed due to high demand, so it is important you bring everything you may need in order to enrol within your designated enrolment time slot.
